"Infant Care" Course

The Greater Carolinas Chapter of the American Red Cross will offer an "Infant Care" course on February 7, 12, and 14, from 7 p.m. - 9 p.m.

Volunteer nurse Dot Heaslip will be the instructor. The course fee for the text and materials is \$15 per couple.

Red Cross "Infant Care" is designed especially for new parents. The course covers such things as bringing the baby home from the hospital, the characteristics of a newborn, feeding, bathing, and infant car seat safety.

The Red Cross will also offer the "Family Health And Home Nursing" course, February 4, 6, 11, 13, 18, and 20, from 6 p.m. - 9 p.m.

Volunteer nurse Mary Frances Coffee will be the instructor. The course fee is \$12.

"Home Nursing" is designed to help people learn how to promote and maintain good health, prevent illness, and perform simple nursing skills in the home.
