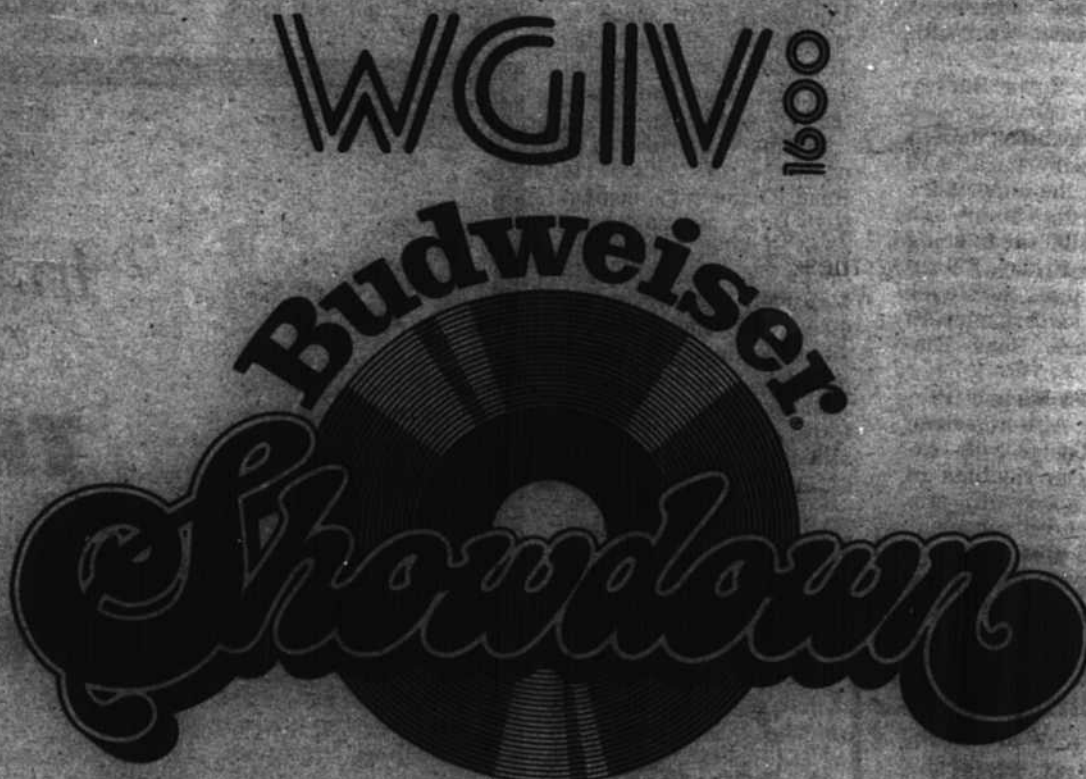
a film project Guthrie is involved in.
