Trade Street, Charlotte, North Carolina, 28204, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

WHEREAS, the Code of Federal Regulations 570.454 requires that prior to submission of a full application for an Urban Development Action Grant the City must hold public hearings to obtain the views of citizens, particularly residents of the area in which the proposed activities are to be carried out.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:
1. That on February 25, 1985 at 3:00 P.M. in the City Council Chamber of City Hall, City Council shall hold the first of two public hearings in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations (570.454) to receive citizens' comments and views on the proposed marketplace project for which the City of Charlotte proposes to apply for an Urban Development Action Grant not to exceed \$3.0 million.
2. That on March 18, 1985 at 6:00 P.M. in the Board Room of the Education Center, City Council shall hold the second and last of two public hearings in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations (570.454) to receive citizens' comments and views on the proposed marketplace project for which the City of Charlotte proposes to apply for an Urban Development Action Grant not to exceed \$3.0 million.
3. That this Resolution shall be published at least once a week for two consecutive weeks in the Charlotte News and in the Charlotte Post, newspapers of general circulation in the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, the first publication not to be less than ten (10) days prior to the date fixed for the first hearing.
