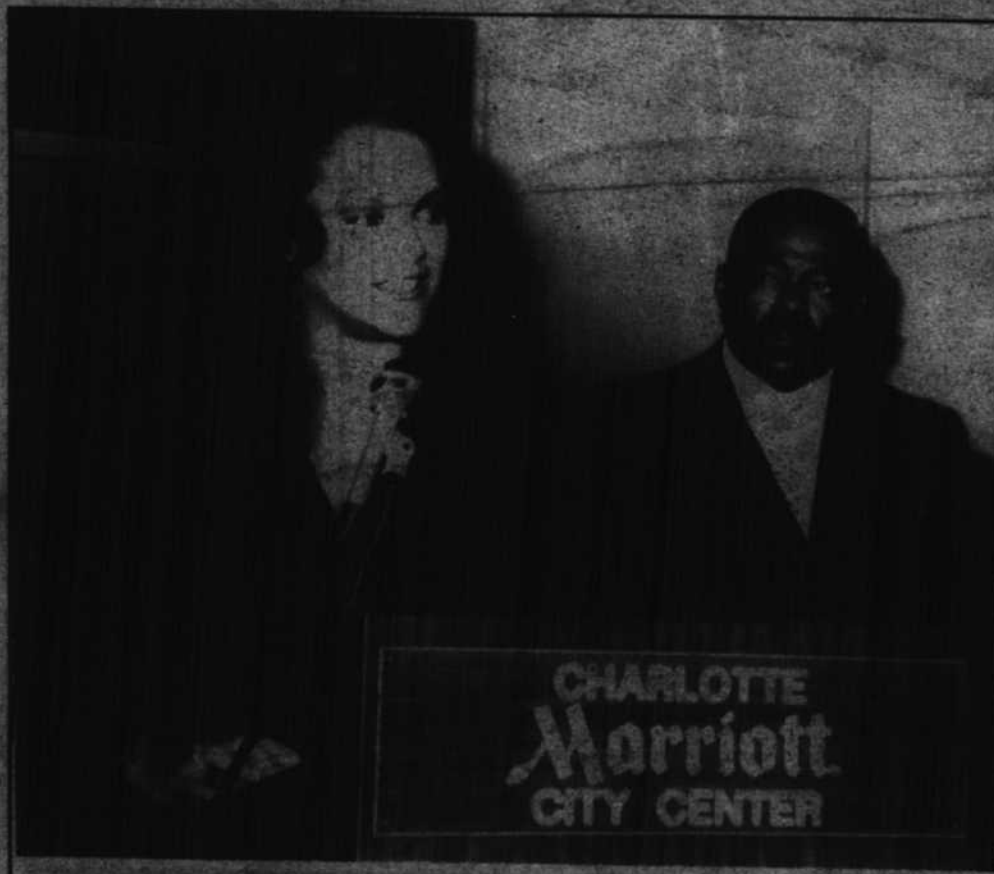


Jayne Kennedy Celebrates Black History With Retail Dealers
