**Dr. Samuel Proctor
To Receive Honorary
Doctoral Degree**

Architect Howell Hamilton Harris and Dr. Samuel D. Proctor, pastor of the Abyssinian Baptist Church of New York City, will receive honorary doctoral degrees from North Carolina State University May 11 at commencement exercises in William Neal Reynolds Coliseum.

Harris is professor emeritus of architecture at NCSU. His work as an architect during the 1940s, '50s and early '60s earned him international acclaim.

Proctor, who is Martin Luther King professor emeritus of education at Rutgers University, was president of N.C. A&T State University from 1960-64. He also has served as president of Virginia Union University, where he earned his bachelor's degree.

A native of Norfolk, Va., Proctor has been pastor of the Abyssinian Baptist Church since 1972. He is the author of "The Young Negro in America, 1960-80" and co-author of "Sermons From The Black Pulpit."

From 1964-69 he held administrative posts with the Peace Corps in Nigeria and in Washington, D.C., the National Council of Churches, the Office of Economic Opportunity, the Institute for Services to Education and the University of Wisconsin.

Proctor has received the Outstanding Alumnus Award from Boston University, where he earned the doctor of theology degree in 1950. More than 20 colleges and universities have awarded him honorary doctoral degrees.

Before coming to NCSU in 1962 as professor of architecture, Harris was the first dean of the School of Architecture at the University of Texas at Austin. An exhibition of his work was held there this spring.

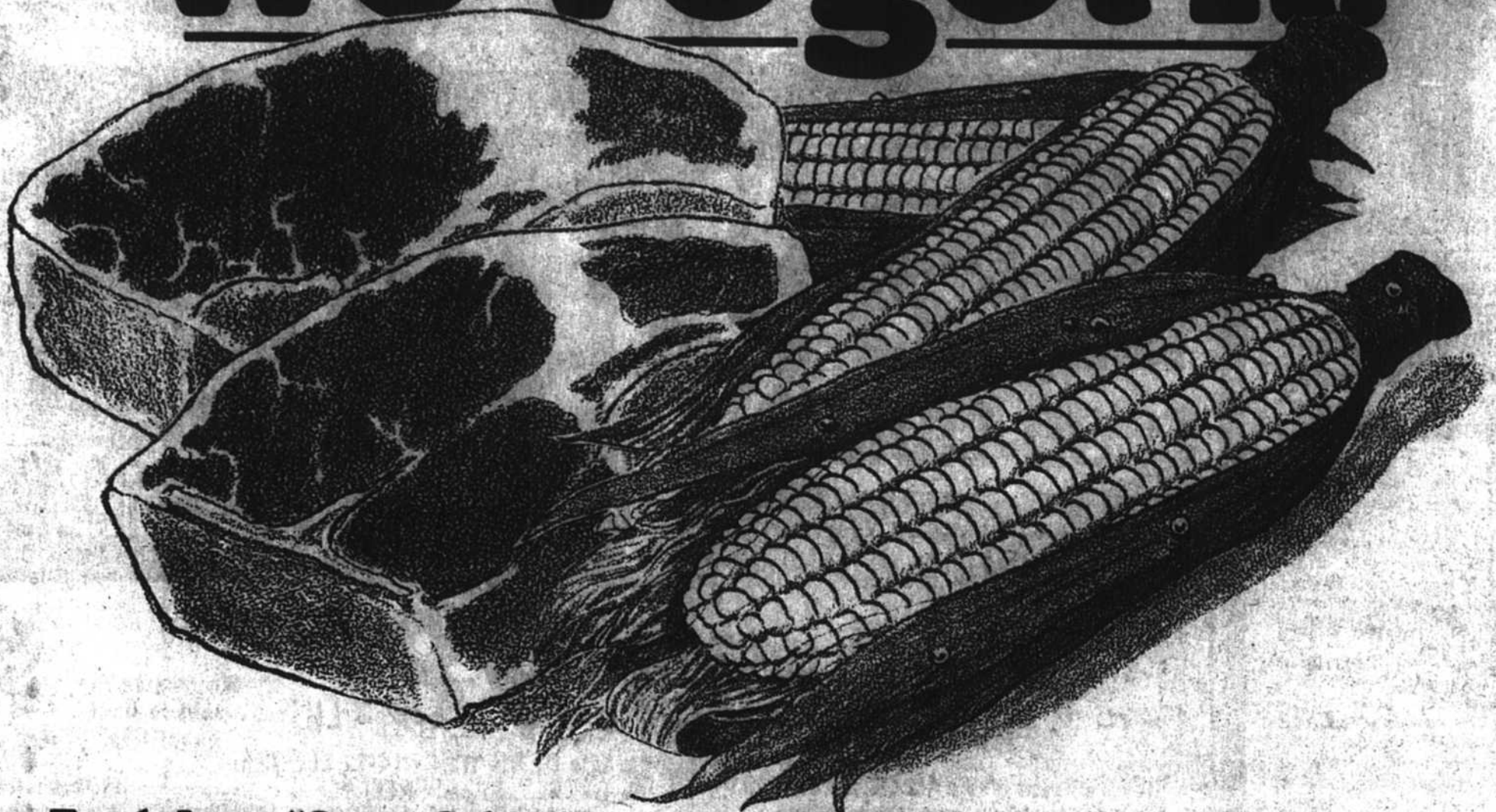
