## Urban Task Force

The task force will study a wide range of issues relating to the status and future of urban transportation in North Carolina

'We must face this issue immediately because of the dramatic growth of our urban areas," Har-rington said. "Governor Martin asked me to form this group to investigate possible solutions and develop a recommended program of action which can be applied to all

our cities and towns."

The Department of Transportation has assessed all existing thoroughfare plans for urban areas with a population of 10,000 or more. This assessment indicates that North Carolina has an urban transportation funding backlog of 40

The Urban Transportation Task Force has broad representation from cities and counties, from the General Assembly and from indi-viduals in the private sector with development and transportation backgrounds. The task force is tentatively scheduled to hold its first meeting on July 10 in Raleigh at the DOT board room in the highway
