1985, following a three-year struggle with cancer. He was 64 years old.

A graduate of Plato Price High School. Thomas was a basketball player for the school's team. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War and was honorably discharged in 1953. He attended Central Piedmont Community College, where he completed course requirements in drafting. Employed with the Duff-Norton Company as a machinist and supervisor for 20 years, Thomas retired in December, 1984.

He is survived by his wife and daughter; two sisters, Mrs. Mary He Clawson and Mrs. Margaret McCullough; mother, Mrs. Myrtle Thompson, step mother-in-law, Mrs. Naomi Love; two brothers-in-law, Harold Clawson and Roger McCullough Sr.; four nephews, three neices, one great nephew, other relatives and a host of dear friends.
