night." McFerrin has won several other awards, including an ACE Award for his long-form video of the Spontaneous Inventions concert. McFerrin's greatest achievement is probably his multi-platinum **Simple Pleasures** LP, which estab-

lished him as a legitimate superstar. McFerrin was a one-man vocal orchestra, layering his voice several times over, creating a spectacularly appealing sound.

The LP also produced "Don't Worry, Be Happy," the song that most epitomized the "me generation" '80s. It was honored with several Grammy

Awards.

Rapper Living Life More Subdued Since Birth Of Son Three Years Ago

LOS ANGELES - For Tone Loc, the raspy-voiced rapper-turned-actor who plays a gunslinger in the film "Posse," guns are more than just make believe.

A former member of the Crips street gang in South Central Los Angeles, Loc has two scars from a bullet that tore through his back and exited his shoulder.

Loc, 25, whose real name is Anthony Terrell Smith, won't reveal the circum-

stances around the wound. But he says his gang days are over.

"The gang will always be a part of me because they're my boys and we're still friends," he said. "But I've changed considerably in the last couple of years. I've done a lot of growing up."

Much of his new attitude is due to the birth of his son three years ago. Loc is raising the boy as a single parent.

"I've been in a lot of life-threatening situations, and I guess I had one close call too

many for someone trying to raise a son," he said. "His birth was like a tap on the shoulder, and I got the message. He needed me around when I'm 40 or 50, and I wasn't going to live long at the pace I was going."

Loc says he was thrilled to be given a role in "Posse," a Mario Van Peebles-directed Western in which most of the main characters are black.

"I'm just like any other kid who dreamed of seeing himself on the big screen," he said. "I'm living a dream come true."
