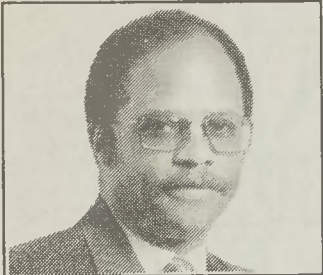

University Park Baptist

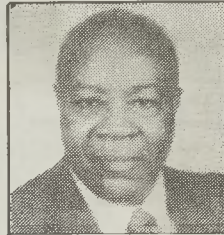

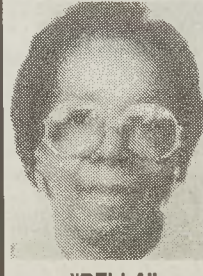
