There's lots of stuff to bring back memories - Rick James' pounding "Give It To Me Baby," Stevie Wonder's third-world-based "Master Blaster (Jammin')" or the Dazz Band's techno masterpiece "Let It Whip" - but there's also

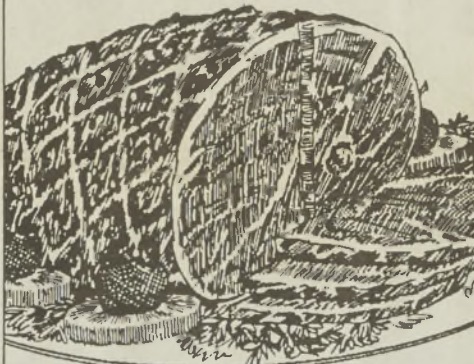
