Nominees for top r&b song include "Brown Sugar" (D'Angelo); "Creep" (Dallas Austin); "For Your Love" (Stevie Wonder); "Red Light Special" (Babyface); and "You Can't Run" (Babyface). Then there's the best r&b album candidates: Mary J. Blige ("My Life"); D'Angelo ("Brown Sugar"); the artist formerly known as Prince ("The Gold Experience"); ("CrazySexyCool"); and Barry White ("The Icon Is Love"). The awards will be broadcast on CBS live from the Shrine Auditorium in Los Angeles on Feb. 28
