he said.

Hollywood's heightened sensitivity to race began well before Jackson's protest, says Jesse Rhines, an assistant professor of political economy at Rutgers University and author of "Black Film-White Money."

Black reaction to O.J.

Simpson's 1995 murder acquittal "was such a huge shock to white people," Rhines said. "They realized there's something so fundamentally different, not just in terms of skin color, but in the cultures, the perceptions of the world."

Rhines says he feels an unprecedented optimism that

in this post-Simpson world Hollywood is finally ready for the black perspective. He points to director John Singleton's "Rosewood" as one proof.

"This is an African-American view of the way blacks have been treated historically," he
