proud of our Constitution, but I cannot accept or comprehend this denial of a basic right that I believe is our heritage from our founding ancestors."

The firing of Pielech and a colleague, Patricia Reed, helped lead to passage of a state law that prohibits religious discrimination.

"No one should have to choose between their job and their need and desire to worship the very God who gave us our freedom," Reed said.
