Faith leads Gastonia man to a victory over cancer

GASTONIA, N.C. (AP) _ Harry Holmes is looking forward to running around the block, going back to work simple things other people take for granted.

He has been through chemotherapy, radiation, a stem cell and a bone-marrow transplant.

Add that to his financial troubles and there were so many problems some called him a "modern-day Job." Yet Harry never lost his faith.

He has confounded his doctors who once held out no hope for him. Now they tell him he should write a book about his experiences.

"I lay it all to the power of prayer," Harry said.

"T had so many folks praying for me, my family, my church family, even strangers who heard or read about me, they were all praying."

were all praying." And the Lord listened, he says.

Seven years ago, the life of Harry and Sandy Holmes seemed to be going along very well. They were planning on retiring in the not-too-distant future.

They started a business, "a little nest egg" where they could work after retirement from their full-time jobs, a business they could pass on to their four children.

In 1997, they purchased Bagel Express & Deli on Union Road in Gastonia. Sandy quit her banking job to become what her customers called "Gastonia's Bagel Lady."

The first two years were successful, but the couple decided they needed a more visible location so they relocated to the Bi-Lo Shopping Center at the corner of Union and Hudson roads. "We met and grew to know

a lot of wonderful people and their families,' Harry said, "and we were determined to make our business prosperous."

The couple put all their personal savings and 401(k) into their business. They even took out a second mortgage on their home.

They took a gamble and lost.

In October of 2000 they had to liquidate their assets and pay off all existing Bagel Express debts on the equipment, vendors, rent, attorney and accounting fees so the new owner of the equipment would be free and clear.

"We decided as a family to put our lives back into the Lord's hands and pray that He would lead us back on track and salvage what we had left," Harry said.





Just as God in His great Sovereignty elected a certain number and ordained them to eternal life in Christ. He ordained a certain number to condemnation or Reprobation. God is Sovereign. Every church member, beginning in the pulpit and classroom, needs to learn the Sovereignty of God. Our religious leaders as a whole have never learned that God is Sovereign. You've never learned that because you have never been taught of the Lord (Isaiah 54:13). It would be funny if it weren't so tragically to see these "jackals" up there trying to teach or preach the Word of God and they have never been taught of the Lord.
