

We recognize the fact that this is an extraordinary event," Kean said. "This does not set a precedent." He said there was still no time set either for Rice's public testi-mony or for Bush and Cheney's private appearance. Administration officials said her appearance probably would come at the end of next week.

Bush is staking much of his re-election bid on his performance as president after the 2001 attacks. But former counterterrorism Bush adviser Richard Clarke - in a best-selling book and testimony before the Sept. 11 commission last week - contended the president had been slow to act against al-Qaida before the attacks and compromised the anti-terror battle afterward by going to war in Iraq.

Opinion polls suggest support for Bush's handling of the war on terror has declined. Two surveys out this week show the presi-dent's approval ratings on that issue are now in the high 50 percent range after being in the mid-60s for months.

Although the erosion has not hurt Bush in one-on-one polling against Democratic rival John Kerry, the White House saw a brewing problem. It waged a vigorous
