In any marriage, there are needs that each spouse needs to be fulfilled. This is especially true when it comes to each spouse's sexual needs. Couples must not deprive each other of the other's natural and reasonable sexual intimacy. Remember, 'God created male and female (Gen 1:27); therefore, such activity is part of God's design for humanity. Now God only permits this activity in the bonds of marriage. Christians cannot be like the world and have sexual activity outside have sexual activity outside of God's bounds.

In marriage, two individuals become one flesh (Gen 2·24). Now they have power

over each other (1 Cor 7:4), over each other (I Cor 7:4), but this is not a license to become a dictator to the other spouse. Rather, it is mutual submission toward each other (Eph. 5:21-23).

4. What exception does Paul give concerning this general rule? (v. 5)

Under normal circumstances, married couples must not withhold sexual pleasure from each other. Verse 5 does provide an exception, a time for fasting and praying. This time should not be too long, and this should be a mutual decision. It is important that married couples do not use spiritual concerns to withhold sexual pleasure from the other partner, especially if this would tempt the other partner to become unfaithful.
