

Bank Executives Named To Board of Advisors

Robert E. Lee, chief executive officer and executive vice president of Tarheel Bank and Trust Company, Gatesville, and Overton S. (Buck) Suiter, Jr., senior vice president of Planters National Bank, Ahoskie, have been appointed to the Board of Advisors. The announcement was made recently by Dr. Bruce E. Whitaker, president.

In making the announcement, Dr. Whitaker said among other duties advisors serve as interpreters of the college in their communities. He said a heavy demand on their time from their work and other civic and community service, Chowan's advisors find time to devote their interest and energies to the college.
