

## Harris Named Week's Citizen

Harris was named chief of the Murfreesboro Police Department in 1979, after working his way up through the ranks. In late 1978, he attended the FBI Academy in Quantico, Va. where he had intensive training in various areas of law enforcement.

Recently, he and five other officers in the county received instruction in Jacksonville to form an emergency REACT team for handling different kinds of emergencies. He is the assistant leader of the REACT team.

Harris is president of the North Carolina-Virginia Law Enforcement Association. The organization is made up of law officers from Richmond to Norfolk, down to Greenville and over to Rocky Mount. "We meet and exchange information on crimes in each other's area," he noted.

The Murfreesboro chief is active in the Roanoke-Chowan Shrine Club and is a member of Meherrin Baptist Church.

Wrote Jennifer Moore, "Ed is a man who loves what he does for a living and enjoys helping other people when he sees a need."

He is married to the former Trudy Britt and they have two sons, Greg and Jeff.

Harris fondly remembers his days at Chowan and recalls that he was a member of the College choir. He retains his interest in music.

He graduated from Chowan with an associate degree in liberal arts. His goal is to receive his political science degree by completing requirements at a college in the vicinity.
