

# Progress Traced of Wood Science Award Recipients

In 1969 the Department of Science decided to honor Miss Mary E. Wood, professor emeritus of biology, by naming the annual science award after her. Miss Wood died last year and the members of the Department of Science were reminiscing about her and the various Science Award winners of years past.

It was decided to purchase a plaque in memory of Miss Wood, to inscribe on it the name of each recipient and place it in the lobby of Carrie Savage Camp Hall (our new science-math facility). During the summer, the Chowan Science Club purchased a beautiful plaque and had it engraved with the name and date of each recipient.

It was suggested that a small follow-up of these individuals be attempted in order to find out where they were and what they were presently doing. This was done by way of a letter to the last known address of each (sometimes to the parent's address). Two letters were returned stamped "Not Deliverable - No Forwarding Address". There was no response from three other inquiries. If someone might know the correct address of these people, please let us know so that we can inform them of this additional honor.
