Class of 1982

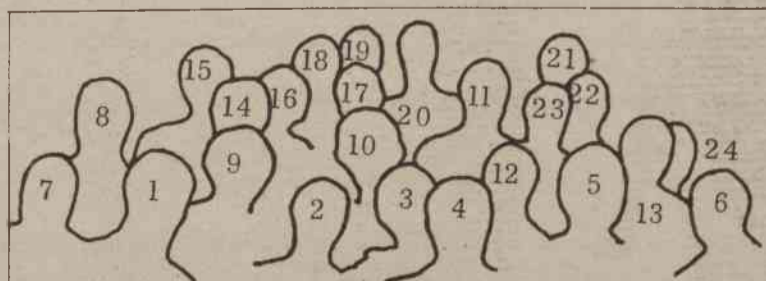
