Former Chowan trustee Mrs. Lessie H. Roberts, of Rolesville, died on Dec. 26, 1984.

Mrs. Roberts most recently completed a four-year term as trustee in 1976. She and her husband, the late William C. Roberts, founded in 1934 and operated the Wake Monument Company.

President Bruce Whitaker said that in the death of Mrs. Roberts, Chowan had lost "a very good friend and supporter. Over the years, she was generous in her support of the college's development program and assisted a number of students to attend Chowan. She was a dedicated, loyal and able trustee whose service meant a great deal to the college."
