School in New Castle, Del. He was All-Conference, team captain and All-State his senior year.

Whaley played in the Delaware Blue-Gold All-Star Game and was captain of the victorious Gold Team.

Enrolling at Chowan in 1962, Whaley was an All-Conference choice and Honorable Mention All-American in 1963 as a quarterback.

Played Professionally

Leaving Chowan, he attended the University of Connecticut where he started as the quarterback and place kicker for two years. As a senior, Whaley quarterbacked the first team in state history to defeat Yale University, passing for 228 yards, kicking two field goals and an extra point.

Honorable Mention All-East Coast as a senior, Whaley went on to play professionally with the Wilmington Clippers of the Atlantic Coast League and was second in the league in passing in 1969. Whaley finished his career with the Harrisburg Capitals of the same league.


Whaley is currently employed by General Chemical Company of New Castle where he lives with his wife Kristine and their daughters, Dawn and Shannon, and son, Justin.


