and prosperous city.

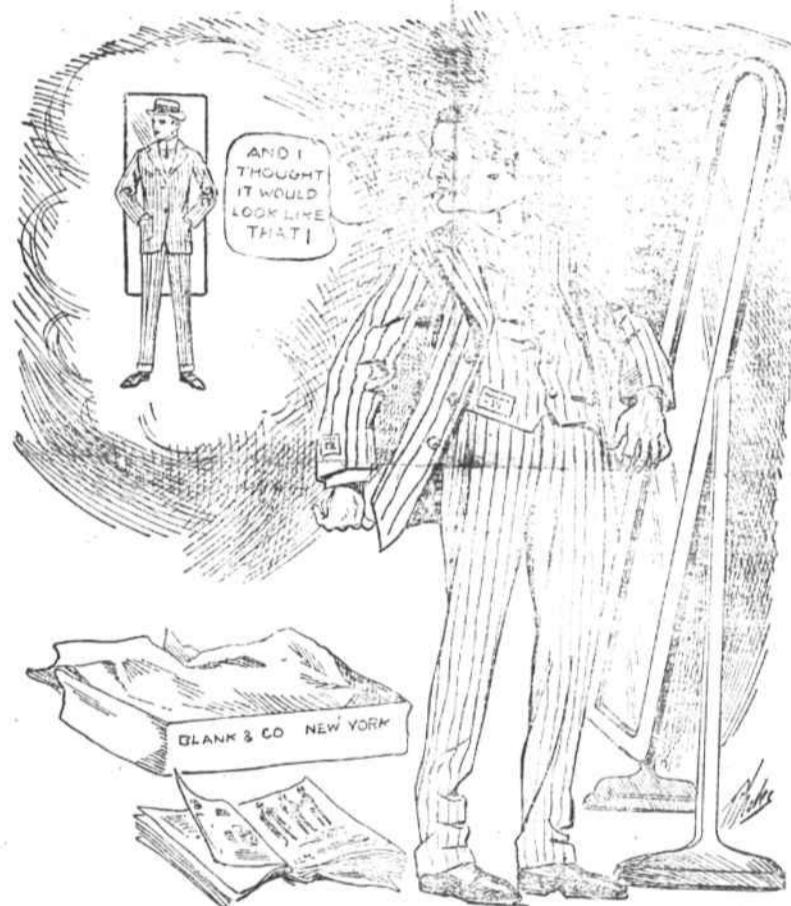
We have a right to feel proud of Washington and of the advancement she is making. And
