He has been in the merchandising business practically all of his life, and employs a total of about six clerks during the rush tobacco season.

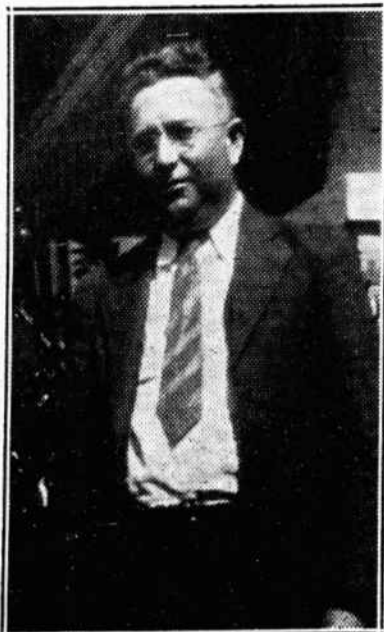
This store carries a full line of ladies', men's and children's ready-to-wear and shoes, and is situated on Madison Street south of the railroad.

J. F. Garrell is sole owner and



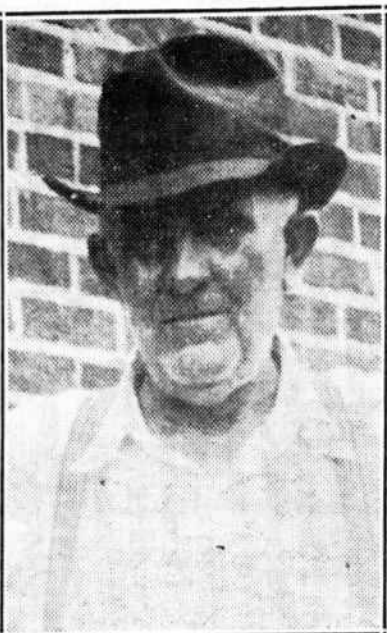
