Clarkton Robbery Denied By Payne

Desperadoes Admit Series Of Infractions, But Deny That They Were Participants In Robbery At Clarkton

Bill Payne and Wash Turner, desperadoes captured in Sanford a week ago, readily admitted to Buncombe officers in Asheville Friday robberies of banks at Candler, Troy and Laurel, but kept mum about the robbery of the Waccamaw Bank & Trust Company's Clarkton branch last May.

Newspaper dispatches from Asheville said that they were questioned about the robbery of the Clarkton banking institution, but while the desperadoes admitted the other three robberies of banks, they did not admit the one at Clarkton.

It has been pretty definitely established, however, that Payne or Turner or both were with Robert Smith, who escaped with them from Candler farm last February, when they entered the Clarkton Bank around noon last May 21, and at the point of a pistol ordered the cashier, Spellman Troy, and two customers in to the vault while they looted the cash drawers for something like \$3,000.

Turner admitted to officers that he was the man who escaped when Bowling Byrd, a pal, was captured near Wilmington, but said nothing of the theft of an automobile in Hallsboro a week later. The machine, property of Mrs. Sarah Creech Forny Duval, was recovered in Durham last Tuesday.

Both Turner and Payne are being held in Asheville where they will face trial for the murder of a N. C. Highway Patrolman.
