 A special election will be held between 7 A. M. and sunset, Eastern Standard Time, January 5, 1940, at which time the registered and qualified voters of the Town of Shallotte the following questions:
 (1) Shall an ordinance passed December 23, 1939 authorizing not exceeding \$10,000 bonds of the Town of Shallotte for paying a portion of the cost of constructing a sanitary sewer system for the Town, and a tax for said bonds, be approved?
 (2) Shall an ordinance passed December 5, 1939 authorizing not exceeding \$7,000 bonds of the Town of Shallotte for paying a portion of the cost of constructing a sanitary sewer system for the Town, and a tax for said bonds, be approved?
 The said bonds are issued in question (1) above authorizes not exceeding \$10,000, Water Bonds to pay a portion of the cost of constructing a sanitary sewer system for the Town. The ordinance referred to in question (2) above authorizes not exceeding \$7,000, Sanitary Bonds to pay a portion of the cost of constructing a sanitary sewer system for the Town.
 It is expected that the Town will be granted from the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works for paying the balance of the cost of each of the two improvements mentioned in the two questions hereinbefore set forth.
