the people toward the militant Finns and the realization that Capitol Hill may be blamed for anything which weakens our neutrality. Therefore, the lawmakers are now juggling the issue with the avowed purpose of passing the buck to the White House.

There is some tension in diplomatic and trade circles over the proposed obligation of the Japanese trade treaty. The State Department is agitated as militant Senators oppose the renewal of business relations with the Nipponese ostensibly because of the Japanese aggression in China. Reports from abroad indicate that the Japanese themselves are concerned over the possibilities of an open rupture in relations. With increasing evidence of inflation and higher taxes directly affecting the public the Japanese diplomats are caught between a cross-fire of the strong army clique and the civilian population, which is resentful at increases in living costs. It is believed that the differences between the two governments will be patched up shortly as Japan is feeling the impact of restrictions on imports due to the European war and the likelihood of having their major market for their products—America—completely blocked in event the trade treaty is not renewed.

Delay In Sowing Tobacco Plant Beds

Many Brunswick county tobacco growers had their plant beds all ready for the seed to be sown by the first of January. They, however, decided to wait for a touch of warm weather. They are still waiting. Even with some of the growers three or four weeks behind their normal time of planting, none seem to be bothered.

WASHINGTON LETTER

Washington, Jan. 22.—Folks whose emotions are swayed by the current dramatics in Congress would do well to place a check in on their optimism. Much of the sentimental play-by-play is more show than real. The House has been engaged in studying the bill introduced last Friday from relatively unknown Federal representative as a means of improving government economy. The hesitancy in Congress is also considered a political gesture to recent trends in public opinion.
