

New Chemical Shows Promise Of Controlling Peach Insects

Peach growers have long kidded each other about keeping control the main insects and dis-

new chemical, known as parathion, offers some hope of cutting down this number.

Dr. Smith has used parathion rather extensively during the past two years in experiments to control plum curculio. Now he reports that it is one of the most promising materials he has tested.

In addition, parathion is showing promise in the control of scale insects, the Oriental fruit moth and peach tree borer. In tests last year the new chemical gave excellent control of the peach borer when four applications were made in May, July, August and September.

Parathion is both a contact and stomach poison, Dr. Smith explains. However it has a residual effect of only four or five days after application.

On the night of September 3rd, 1936, Lou Ambers fought through fifteen blistering rounds to become Lightweight Champion of the World. That's history.

News? Much more than news. 'Twas an event of far-reaching effect. For world champions of the ring are more adulated and imitated than world leaders of arts and sciences, of professions and industries, of kingdoms and empires.

Lou Ambers, here's to you! May the memory of your fifteen-round victories never grow dim. May your Nine First Fridays go on and on. May you ever shine forth as a model of physical and spiritual strength for every little boy—yep, and for every great big man.
