He admitted that rotation had some merit, but contended the arguments against the system far outweighed its advantages.

Solicitor Moore referred to "our judicial system as the heart and citadel of American freedom" and said the major reform which North Carolina could make would be to abolish the policy of shifting judges one district to an-
