Pays to Reform Boys.

In order to find out whether it pays a State to maintain reformatories for the care and training of bad boys...

The highest salary was \$100 a month and the lowest \$20 and board. Many were earning \$80, \$70, \$65, \$60, and \$52 monthly.

Making a very conservative estimate, the 65 per cent only of the more than two thousand boys who have been sent back to Chicago...

Taking the same average of 65 per cent of the 6,000 boys already paroled from the institution, and of the earnings just enumerated, we have \$2,000,000 as the amount annually paid them.

Thus the graduates of two out of the ten adult reformatories in the United States are being paid more than \$6,000,000 a year.
