EXPORTS GAIN
The U. S. Department of Agriculture reports that American farmers sold \$155,000,000 more agricultural products abroad during the fiscal year 1937-38 than during the previous twelve months.

Purchase of cotton and cotton products up to \$250,000 in value for projects to develop new commercial uses for cotton have been authorized by the AAA in a diversion program.

Many peanut fields in Virginia and North Carolina have been reported as abandoned after heavy rains brought on an extreme grassy condition, says E. Y. Floyd of State College.

REVISIONS
Secretary of Agriculture Henry Wallace has announced that revisions will be made in tobacco quotas where the allotment seems inequitable.

LEAVES HOME
A recent survey by Ray E. Wakeley, rural sociologist at Iowa State College, indicated that more than one-half of the rural children of Iowa leave home and of these one out of five leaves the state.
