CHILD SUCCUMBS TO PTOMAIN POISONING

New Bern, July 8—Bertha May, six, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. H. B. Griffin, of Clarks this county, died

heretoday of ptomaine poisoning, while three other children of the family were seriously ill with the disease at their home. The parents and physicians were at a loss to know how the children became poisoned. They were taken Sunday morning, Bertha May being brought to the hospital here in the afternoon.

The body of Phillip Leary, negro, about 45, was found on the Norfolk Southern tracks about six miles east of New Bern Sunday morning with his head crushed as though by a severe blow. The body was found by Tom Styron, of Raleigh, engineer on a special troop train returning from Camp Glenn, about 3:30 o'clock. The man is believed to have gone to sleep

on the track and was hit by an east bound train earlier in the night.

OUTLOOK FOR TOBACCO CROP IN EASTERN CAROLINA GOOD

Kinston, July 9—Crop conditions in eastern Carolina are improving. The prospect for better prices for tobacco is encouraging farmers. Authorities here expressed the opinion today that the weed will bring more than in 1928. This opinion was entertained by experts at the national gathering of tobaccoists at Virginia

Beach last month.

E. V. Webb, a governor of the Tobacco Association of the United States, today predicted prosperity for the eastern third of the state this fall. "I look for better prices," he said. "Dealers' stocks are not large and the demand for tobacco of the better grades should be good."

Condition of the crop in this belt has improved rapidly in recent weeks. The yield will be off in some counties but in the belt as a whole a normal harvest is expected. The crops of 1927 and 1928 were above normal.

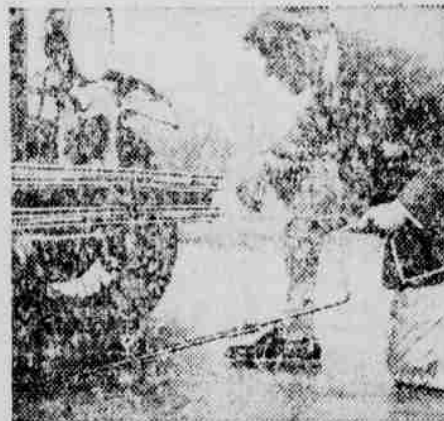

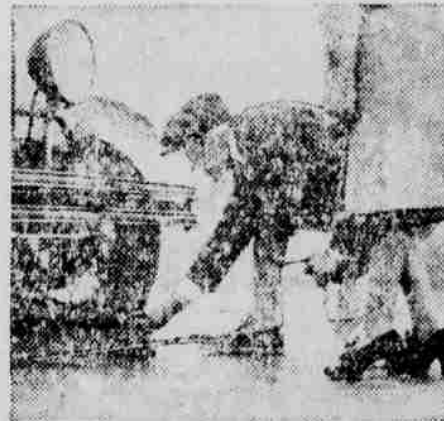
