"Where these canot be sold fresh, they should be placed in brine at once and converted into pickles later. The method to use is simple and costs very little. After curing, the cucumbers may be kept as long as desired or until it becomes possible to sell them at the curb markets or to pickle manufacturers. This helps out the over-production problem and assures the pickle market of a steady supply."

Curing cucumbers for pickle is accomplished by a lactic fermentation in brine. The juice of the cucumber is withdrawn and the brine takes its place causing the cucumber to become hard and firm. The presence of salt also checks spoilage.


