SCARBORO-SAFRIT Co., has a complete plant. It represents an in-

vestment of nearly \$200,000 and in addition to sawing rough lumber from the logs you see piled up adjacent to the plant, it also kiln dries the timber and then re-saws boards in the planing department.

SCARBORO-SAFRIT employs approximately 100 men at the plant. That is the steadiest pay-roll in the county because that number is working there year in and year out.
