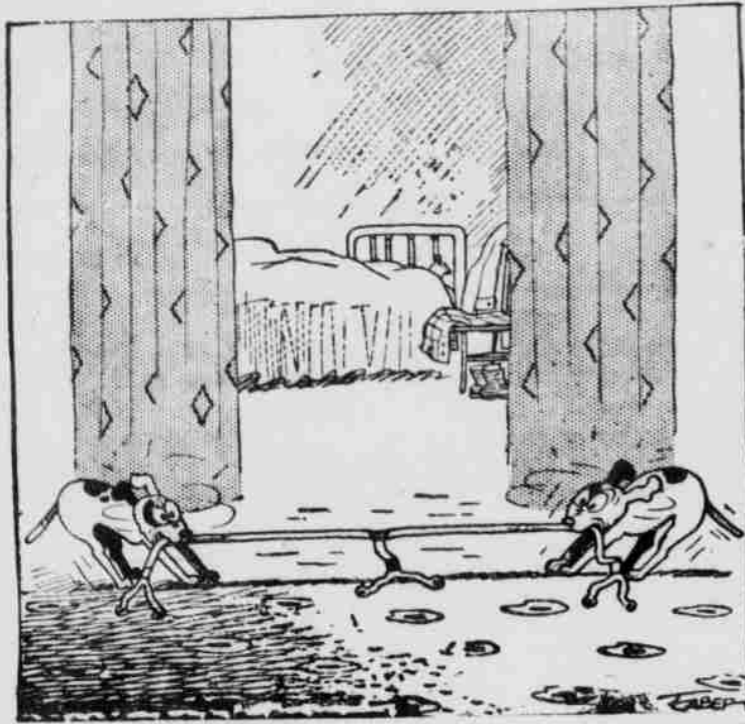


THEN THE FUN BEGAN

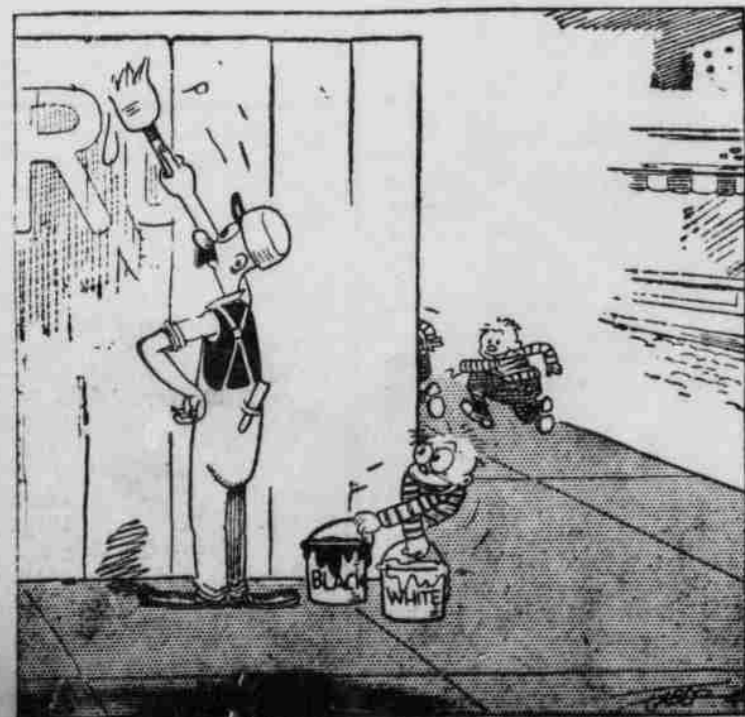
Atlantic made fifteen hits and five errors. Longest striking out four men. The Islanders recorded eight hits and six errors, their three hurlers fanning one.

Dusting should be repeated each week until the weevils are controlled. Calcium arsenate is recommended in amounts varying according to the conditions of each field.

Full details about weevils and dusting may be obtained free from the entomology department at State College, Dr. Metcalf added.

Weevils May Attack Cotton This Summer

RALEIGH, June 30—North Carolina's cotton crop is rather expensive feed for boll weevils.

Let cotton be considered just that when weevils "take" a field and keep it from producing a good yield of lint, said Dr. Z. P. Metcalf, head of the entomology department at State College.

If the weather is warm and cloudy in July, with frequent showers, boll weevil infestations will probably be heavy in North Carolina this summer, he continued.

But if hot, dry weather predominates, it may keep the weevils from multiplying to any serious extent.

In recent years, Dr. Metcalf pointed out, weather has been unfavorable to weevils, and no great damage has been done in this State, "but we can't expect the right weather every summer."

He also pointed out that the mild winter just passed was not cold enough to kill many of the hibernating weevils.

Every week in August, he continued, growers should examine their cotton closely, and start dusting as soon as 10 per cent of the squares are found to be infested.
