the State there are 1500 of them are active practitioners, 1200 counts of their experience with the disease, and 800 of them, representing all sections of engaged in treating the disease. Twenty-five counties have al-
ready made grovisions for the dispensaries, besides those appropriating for the dispensarie the first Monday in December.
36,00 people have been micro
scopically examined for hooksorm isease. A large number of those treated had such heavy infection that the microscopic ex-
