Fireworks Ordinance.

Suggested by National Fire Protection Association.

Prohibiting the discharge or firing of fireworks and other pyrotechnic display and to limit their storage. Be it ordained by people of the ___of_____

Section No. 1. The discharge, firing or use of all firecrack 6 ers, rockets, torpedoes, Roman candles, or other fireworks or substances designed and intended for pyrotechnic and display, and of all pistols, canes, cannons or other appliances, using blank cartridges or caps containing chlorate of potash mixture, is hereby prohibited. Provided that _____ may order the public display of fireworks by properly qualified individuals under the direct supervision of experts in the handling of fireworks. Provided also that such display or displays shall be of such a character and so located, discharged or fired as, in the opinion of the Chief of the Fire Department, shall not be hazardous to surrounding property or endanger any person or persons.

SECTION No. 2. The sale of fireworks at retail is prohibited. SECTION No. 3. The storage or sale of fireworks at wholesale Sanday School every Sabbath, is prohibited, expect by permit from the ______issued

for a period of one year. Application for permit must be filed with the Chief of the Fire Department at least 30 days previous Labbath, 11:00 a. m. and 8:00 p. to the issuing of the permit and must give details description of the proposed care and storage of said materials and of the struc-Mid-week Service every Thurs- tural conditions and occupancies of the building.

Section No. 4. Permits may be issued only after an inspection of the premises by the Chief of the Fire Department or his authorized agent, who shall file with the Mayor and Fire Department a certificate of approval or his disapproval and reason there-

Section No. 5. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance as regards the storage and sale of fire works shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than Twenty-five \$25.-(00) Dollars for each day's neglect of compliance. Provided also that violation of other sections of this ordiance shall be considered Prayer-meeting, Wednesday a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding Ten (10.00)

> The Chief of the Fire Department may, at this discretion. remove or have removed, at the awner's expense, all stocks of fireworks or other combustible coposed for sale, or held in stock in

> Section No. 6. The Oxief of the Fire Department shall direct such tire appliances as in his judgement may be necessary for the premises, and he shall see that two or more persons are instructed in the use and as to the best means of getting fire alarms to the Fire Department.

Section No. 7. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistentent herewith are hereby repealed. SECTION No. 8. This ordinace shall take effect and be in force




