DEFINE DEPONDE OF LEGISLATURE CALLED BY GOVERNOR CRAIG

Raleigh, N. C., July 18.—Governor Craig will leave tomorrow morning for Asheville N. C. for a short stay. The constitutional amendment commission having completed its labors, Governor Craig desided to issue a call for the special session of the legisla-ture. The call of course, takes the form of a proclamation by the Governor and requests legislators to reassemble on September 24. It is noteworthy that the first purpose designated by the governor in calling the legislature into extra session relates to the subject of freight rates. The proclamation follows:

By and with the advice of the Council of State, I, Locke Craig, Governor of the State of North Carolina, in the exercise of the power conferred upon me by the Constitution and in occordance with the resolution passed by the General Assembly and ratified on the 6th day of February, 1913, do issue this my proclamation on this extraodinary occasion, convening, the General Assembly in Extra Session.
