"Notice is hereby given that on April 18, 1913, an election will be held in the City of Charlotte for the submission to the qualified voters of the City of Charlotte of two Acts, one entitled, "An Act to revise the Charter of the City of Charlotte," and the other entitled, "An Act to provide a Commission Form of Government for the City of Charlotte," both ratified by the General Assembly of North Carolina on March 6, 1913.
