


Col. Amos Kimball, chief quartermaster at New York, has been ordered to this city to consult with General Ludington in regard to the supplies for Chronic diseases and diseases of the artillery posts, and already a large amount of these have been forwarded to the posts concerned.

> In the Signal Corps bureau, Maj. George P. Scriven, who rushed a telegraph line from Pekin to the coast in advance of all other nations, and Lieut. Henry S. Hathaway have been ordered to New London, Conn. Tihs apparently will be headquarters for the corps, and Gen. Greely will be there in person. During his absence Maj. Richard E. Thompson, now chief officer at Fort Myers, will be in charge of nis office. The artillery companies stationed at the defenses of Long Island are to be given an opportunity to brush up on their marksmanship just before the naval attack of the North Atlantic Squadron, under Rear Admiral Higginson, begins. During the interval between August 25-the closing day of the naval search problem which is now in progress-and September 1, when the joint maneuvers are scheduled to begin, extensive target practice will be indulged in at the defenses named and also at the other morts along the New England coast. The principal feature of the practice at the Long Island forts will be firing at moving targets, proficiency in which impending attack of the war vessels. The targets are rigged in various ways, some of them being fashioned to represent a warship. They are to be drawn past the forts by small tugs. A number of the ordnance officers on duty at the War Department left Washington last night to be present at the target work, and Gen. Crozier, chief ordnance officer, who is a member of Gen. MacArthur's staff, is expected to view the work at the several forts. The War Department will issue an order in a few days giving general instructions to govern competition in this target practice along the coast.
