**THE WEATHER.**

**Forecast for Charlotte and Vicinity.**  
Increasing cloudiness and probably rain late tonight or Sunday; warmer tonight.

**State Forecast.**  
Increasing cloudiness; rain late tonight or Sunday; warmer tonight.

**Weather Conditions.**  
Atmospheric pressure is high this morning east of the Mississippi river and south of the Ohio, and fair weather has prevailed during the last 24 hours in all sections east of the Rocky mountains except for light snowfall in the extreme Northeast.

**Pressure** has decreased decidedly west of the Mississippi, a storm area of considerable force having developed with its center today near Duluth, Minn. These conditions have caused unsettled weather, with general snows over the Rockies, the upper Plateau region and the north Pacific states.

The temperature has risen over the greater part of the country, but it continues low in the Southern states, and frosts were again reported from the South Atlantic and east Gulf states as far south as Tampa, Mobile and New Orleans. The weather has grown decidedly warmer throughout the territory between the Mississippi and the Rockies, and in the Northwest.

The eastward drift of the Western disturbance will result in increasing cloudiness in this vicinity, with probably rain late tonight or Sunday; warmer tonight.

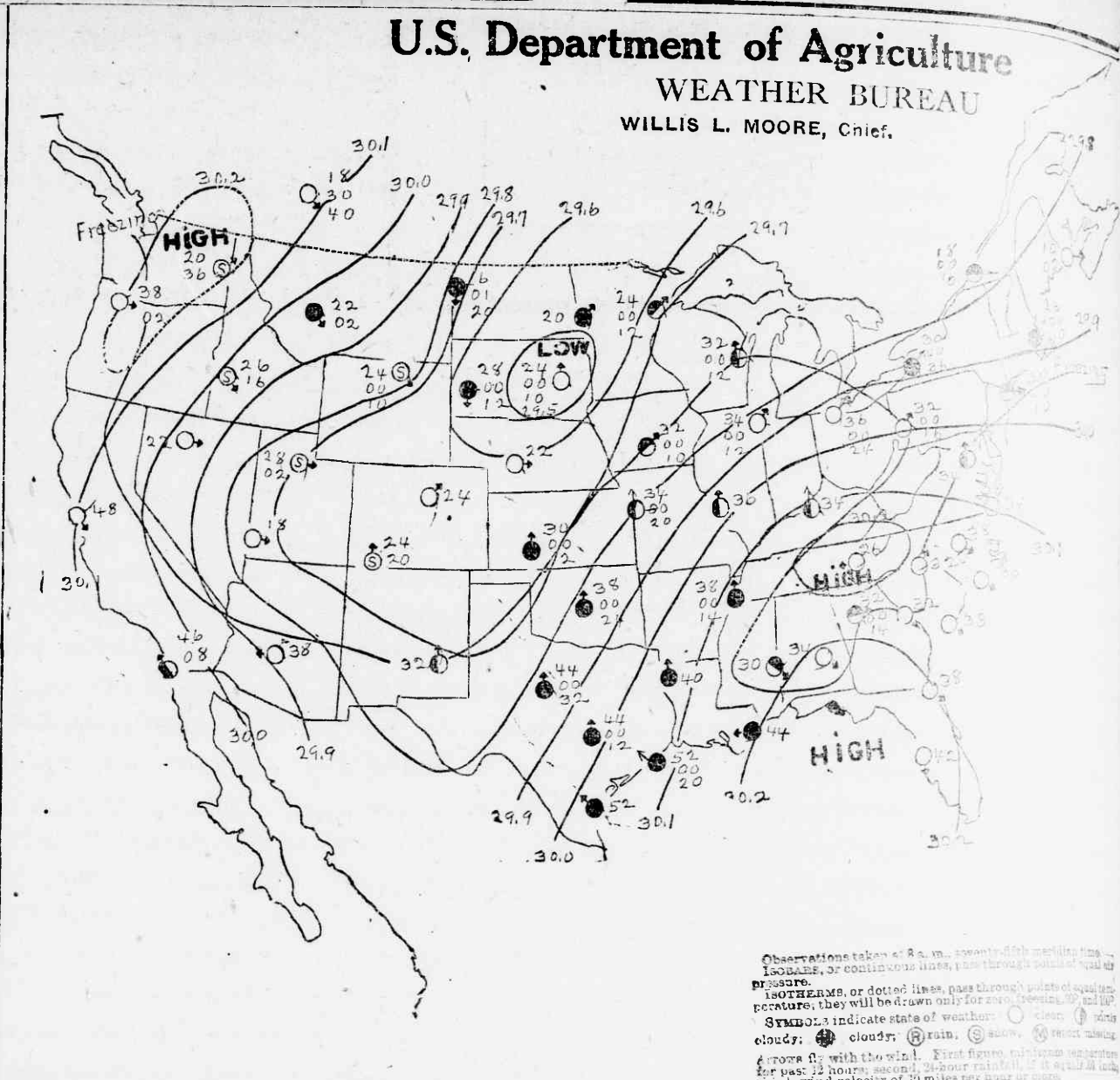

**Edge Fires in Richmond.**  
Richmond, Va., Feb. 25.—The edge fires destroyed the R. B. Williams & Co. tobacco stemmers at Williams and Carey streets and the large plant 3 to 9 South Twenty-nine street this city. Loss about \$100,000. The plant is covered by insurance. Employees of employees trapped in the burning buildings and of firemen working by smoke were features of the spectacle. Several firemen were injured, none of them seriously, however. The Henrico central jail was one time threatened by the flames as the prisoners were removed to other prison. They were punished for the fire. Both Williams & Co. and the tobacco Company will start up work as soon as possible.
