

State Highway Commission Bill De feated.

The bill to encourage road building in North Carolina by state aid through the state issuing 5 per cent bonds and letting the counties have the proceeds on 4 per cent bonds for road building came up in the senate as amended by the house. It was explained that the senate had formerly passed the bill to provide for the state highway commission but stricken out the sections providing for bond issue by the state and that the house, in its turn. struck out the highway commission feature and restored the state bond issue feature. Senator Kitchin moved to table the bill. This failed 23 to 20. A motion

by Senator Pharr to postpone was unsuccessful. In the discussion that followed Sen-

ator Barnes and Senator Thorne protested against phenominally persistent lobbying that they alleged some of the state officers were doing for this bill to force it through the legislature.
