Lisbon, March 20.—The Monarchists, taking advantage of the division and antagonism among the republicans, are distributing money lavishly to spread dissatisfaction in the capital and throughout the provinces. The government's postponement of the election for the fourth time now, until May 14, has made a disagreeable impression upon the public. The announced reason for this delay in submitting to the people the choice of a president and government is that the clergy have undue anti-government influence in various northern districts and there is need of more time to further the republican campaign.

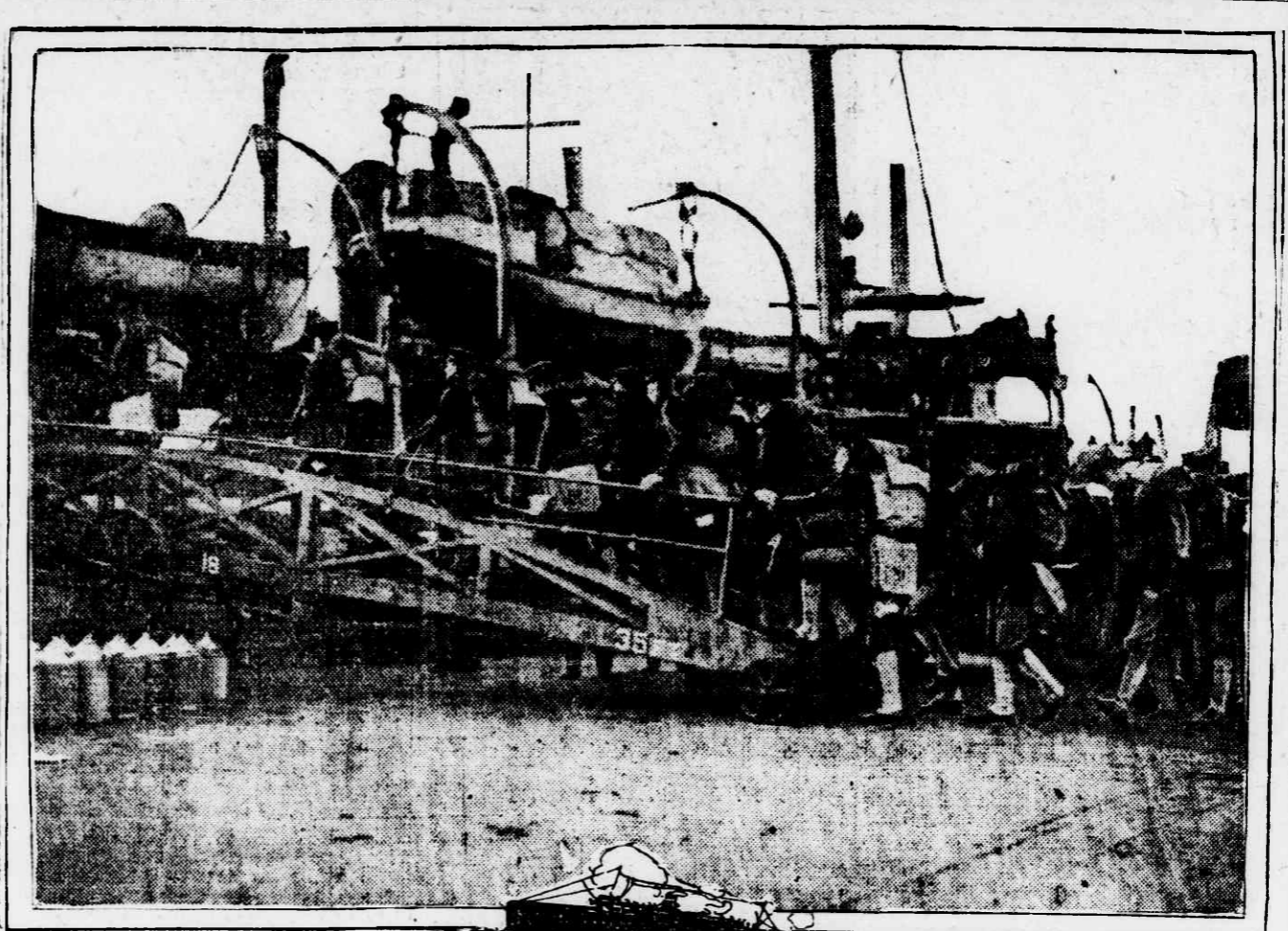

Joe Turner, the wrestler who is so favorably known here, is expected to arrive from Washington today, and complete all arrangements for his match, Wednesday night with Burt Hudson, the gamest little fellow who ever tried a toe hold. The match will take place in the Auditorium and will be witnessed by a crowd the like of which has not attended any match here this season.

People of Charlotte know Turner and have confidence in his ability to cope with any man his weight. They have heard of Hudson. The match is a handicap affair, Turner agreeing to throw Hudson twice within ninety minutes. If he turns the trick he will have accomplished a feat that will pronounce him the greatest wrestler in the country at his weight. For Burt Hudson (Al Ackerman) is the cleverest wrestler ever to come to the southland. He knows the game thoroughly and is quick, active and strong. If Hudson is in the same condition he was two years ago—and he writes that he is even better—it is the opinion of this writer that he will give Joe Turner the hardest battle of his career.
