New York, June 19.—Stocks responded to a vigorous buying movement at the opening of the stock market today and prices improved.

A decidedly stronger tone prevailed this morning in the stock market, which exhibited none of the weakness that appeared toward the close of last week.

Some of the Southern group of stocks responded to reports of widespread rains in the cotton districts and the whole market was measurably benefited by the steady accumulation of favorable news.

Active stocks had eased off a trifle from the best, but the undertone continued strong and a number of specialties and minor railroad stocks moved up materially.

Oats advanced promptly in consequence of general commission purchasing. Offerings were light.

Provisions held steady with hogs. Packers were not doing much. First sales varied from 2 1-2 off to 2 1-2 gain.

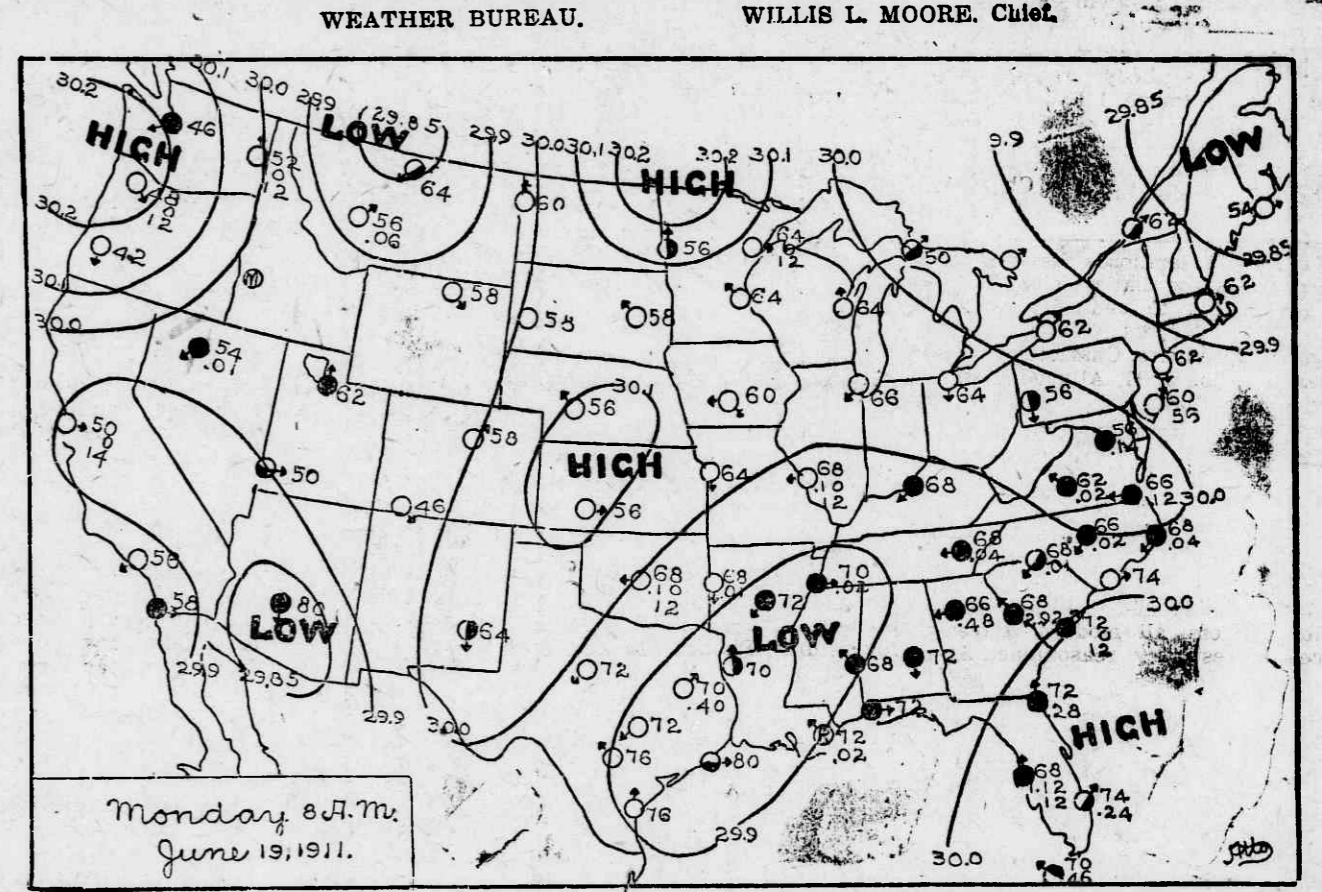
