New York Cotton

New York, Aug. 25.—The cotton market opened firm at an advance of 24 points on August and of 9 1/2 points on other months in response to higher cables, reports that the Liverpool strike had been settled, and bullish private crop accounts. August was relatively firm as the result of a little buying by scattered shorts, but the advance was checked by realizing at 12 7/8, and later months eased off a few points from the best during the early trading under Southern selling, realizing by recent local buyers and some pressure, which may have been encouraged by reports of further rains in the Southwest and prospect for showers again today. The market during the middle of the morning was nervous and unsettled with new crop months about 6 to 7 points net higher.

Estimated receipts at the ports to-day 15,000 bales against 7,442 last week and 11,257 last year. At New Orleans today 1,503, against 554 last week, and 121 last year. At Houston today 13,380 against 8,829 last year and 11,934 last year.

New York Stock Market

New York, Aug. 25.—Selling of stocks was resumed at the opening today with new low records in Lehigh Valley and Amalgamated Copper which declined a point each. United States Steel opened with sales of 6,000 shares at a fractional loss and Southern Pacific, Reading, Northern Pacific and Erie were of substantial fractions. The only notable gain was 3/4 of a point in Canadian Pacific.

The market became more active on the decline directly after the opening, a number of stocks joining the year's low level. Weakness was most pronounced in Reading and Lehigh Valley, but the entire list with a few unimportant exceptions reflected severe pressure.

Another drive against prices in the early afternoon sent the Harriman and Hill stocks still lower, as well as Amalgamated Copper and American Smelting, United States Steel fell to its previous low and the entire market was once more unsettled.

Chicago, Aug. 25.—A sag in the wheat market here today resulted from the fact that stocks at the quays in Liverpool had been released by the ending of the strike. Bearish influence came also from the crop situation in northwest Canada, where the harvest is only a week off and another night of escape from frost had made the outlook more flattering.

Purchases by a leading house on the bull side made corn firm. Trade otherwise, however, was scattered. December opened 1-8 1/4 to 1-4 higher at 62 1-8 to 62 1-8 1/4 and then reacted.

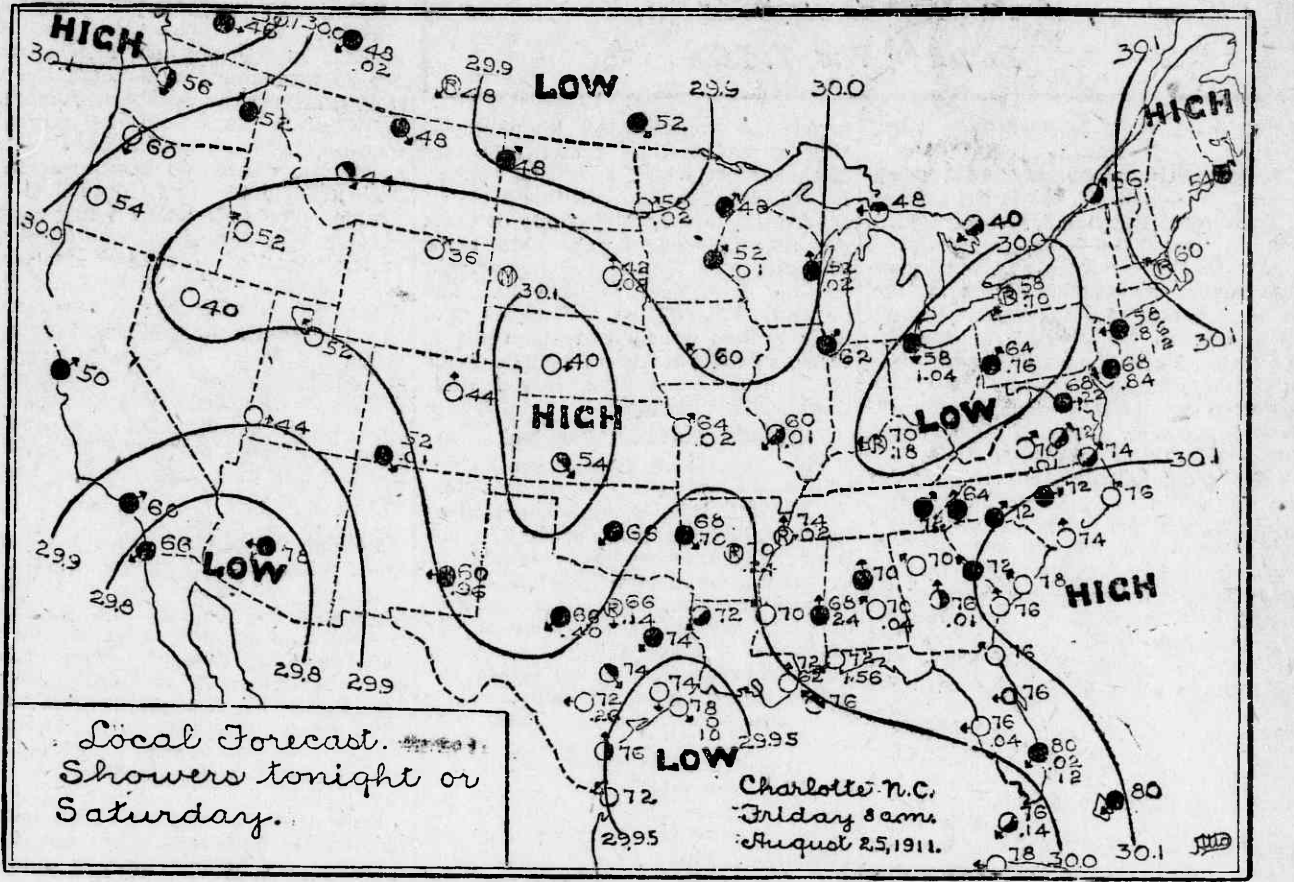
