

Pre-registration To Be Held April 29-May 6

All continuing degree and non degree students who intend to return for the Fall Semester, 1968 must complete pre-registration during the period April 29 through May 6. Pre-Registration has been arranged to handle certain groups of students during specified days. Please observe the schedule. If you cannot come on the days designated for you, you may go through pre-registration on any day following your assigned time, but not before.

(1) ADVISING AND COMPLETION OF OFFICIAL PRE-REGISTRATION SCHEDULE REQUEST CARD

The student will meet with his advisor to discuss the student's schedule. The student will have a copy of the Schedule of Courses,

Fall Semester, 1968, prior to this and will have worked out a trial schedule. The Official Pre-Registration Card will be secured from the advisor who will sign it for the student. The student brings this card to the Records Office on one of the designated days assigned for his registration according to his class designation. All cards are due and must be processed in the Records Office before 5:00 p.m. on May 8, 1968.

Schedule for Students to bring signed Pre-Registration Schedule Request Cards to the Records Office, room 136 Administration Building any time between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on the days assigned for that student's particular groups.

Rising Seniors - Monday, April 29, 1968 or Tuesday, April 30, 1968

Rising Juniors - Wednesday, May 1, 1968 or Thursday, May 2, 1968

Rising Sophomores - Friday, May 3, 1968 or Monday, May 6, 1968

(2) PAYING OF FEES

Students will not make payment of fees for the Fall Semester until after July 1, 1968. A statement explaining fees and payment of fees will be supplied later.

(3) COMPLETION OF REGISTRATION AND PICKING UP SCHEDULES

Pre-registered students must return to the University on Monday, September 9, 1968, to pick up a printed copy of their schedule and to complete registration cards. A student will not be officially registered unless he picks up his schedule on that day. If the schedule is not picked up on this day these classes will be made available for other students and you must go through regular registration.

PLEASE NOTE:

It will be assumed by the University that those who fail to pre-register do not plan to return for the Fall Semester, 1968.

(2) Fall Semester fees will not be paid until after July 1, 1968, but before September 9, 1968.

(3) The student who does not pre-register will have to go through regular registration which may mean a less desirable schedule, picking up course cards, and waiting in lines.

(4) The student who follows the pre-registration instructions carefully should experience no difficulty in obtaining satisfactory class schedules and a minimum of time required for completion of all tasks.

The United States is the world's leading consumer of newsprint, using 9,149,000 tons in 1967. 46.5 per cent of world demand, excluding Red China, the Newsprint Association of Canada reports.

This newsprint was consumed by 324 morning newspapers, 1,403 evening newspapers with a circulation of 61,381,053. 587 Sunday newspapers with a circulation of 48,963,169 and 9,323 weekly newspapers with a circulation of 26,876,725.

Newspapers are read on the average day in 46,570,000 or 86.4 per cent of the American households, according to the Bureau of Advertising of the American Newspaper Publishers Association.
