Perhaps the most interesting results of the mock-election were the surprising strengths of SenaCloser examination of the ballots revealed certain inconsistencies which would seem to indicate that some took the mock-election with mock-seriousness; Republicans voting for Wallace and Hawkins, Democrats voting for Stickley and against Tobacco taxes, etc. 378 votes were cast in support of liquor by the drink, with 88 opposed, while 344 advocated a tobacco tax and 113 voted against the same.
