## University Announces New Divisional Structure

Carolina at Charlotte has announced a new divisional structure for its academic program.

The plan was approved by the Executive Committee of the University of North Carolina Board of Trustees.

Under the plan the University will be organized into six divisions with possibly one or two more added later. Chairmen were appointed to head the new divisions.
