If you're not a Fiedler-Pops fan, hear this one—you will be. "Up up and Away"; theme from "Valley of the Dolls"; "Georgy Girl"; "Yesterday"; Mozart, Piano Concerto No. 21: Andante (featured in the film "Elvira Madigan")—are all superb! superb! superb!
