Each day the 49ers were encouraged to improve their scores and times of the previous workouts. The coaches did this by grading the players from 1-10 on each event. Coach Foster was extremely pleased with the results and enthusiasm of these pre-season workouts. Everything is pointing in the direction of an even better season for the UNCC 49ers.


